3. Read the instructions through first before you start, so you get the gist of what you are doing.
4. Pay particular attention to the way pieces go together, some items will have a front and back and can assemble both ways, but only one way will look correct.
5. Don't force things. If you have to force an item, the chances are you are doing something wrong and you run the risk of breaking it.
6. Be gentle but firm in assembly. Many of the parts may be a little weak until assembled, so tighten and make sure everything is secure, but don't overtighten and break it.
