So, our challenge is going to be to get a bathroom cleaned. It's a dirty job, but someone's got to do it. And you know what else? Once you have cleaned it a couple of times, it sure does make you want to keep it cleaner in the future.

- 1. Remove all the items from the bathroom. I'm talking toothbrushes, mats, bottles, everything. And, by the way, be careful where you put them, some of those bottles and things can be a bit mucky themselves.
- 2. Sanitize the toilet. You'll need to use bleach and a toilet brush, or you could use one of those newfangled toilet scrubbers. Bottom line, you need to scrub it well.
- 3. Now with bathroom spray, spray and wipe down the toilet seat, the rim, and even the sides of the toilet to the floor. I usually wipe up with toilet paper so I can throw it right into the toilet.
- 4. Now, spray down the other bathroom surfaces and wipe them down.
- 5. The sink will need scrubbing. I usually use the spray there, and then half fill the sink and wash everything down the plug hole.
- 6. Clean out that bathtub. The spray can come in handy there too. Again, fill



the bathtub a little and wash the water down the drain. A cloth can also be useful to get rid of soap scum lines.

7. Finally, that floor will need mopping or vacuuming.

These are some very basic guidelines. Go through these with your parents and customize them for your particular bathroom.
