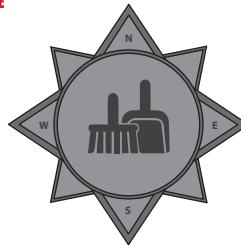


CLEANING WINDOWS

- Now, if you are going to do this right, you'll have to remove the window screens so that you can clean the outside. Understandably the upstairs ones may be a little dangerous, but the downstairs ones that can be reached should be fair game. Remove the screens, vacuum them, and wash with warm soapy water and sponge or rag.
- Then, clean the window frame. It's not a bad idea to vacuum first, and then clean with hot soapy water and a sponge. Dry with a cloth to prevent dirty drips on the frame.
- I'm going with some of the age-old methods for cleaning the glass. Clean off the stubborn stains first with a mixture of half water and half vinegar. The idea being, if you start cleaning the windows, and then you go back to remove stubborn stains, you'll have to clean the windows again. But if you start with the stains, it should be smooth sailing from there on out.



* Now you can use Windex or some other common store-bought product. Many people make their own blend of with dish soap and a dash of vinegar. For streak-free windows, a squeegee is recommended by the experts. It's up to you what you want to invest.
