So make sure you communicate. Talk to the baby and show them things. They love to hear voices and see things. Sure they may not understand what you are saying. Be careful with the music that you

play. Select something appropriate and have a little dance party.

Read or tell stories. Books with flaps, textures, or pop-ups are especially good.

Encourage the baby to develop the skills it is learning. If crawling, set objects and encourage them to crawl. If they are turning over, encourage them in this and help them practice.

Funny faces, Peek-a-boo, stack blocks or cups, or

anything that engages the baby can be used. They especially like to knock things down or anything really that makes them realize that they have the power to affect something in this world.
