Find three geocaches. Return home with three new items.

- 1. First, you will need to find a geocaching website that you like the look of. You'll probably have to create an account. If you are using a smart phone there are many apps that you can choose from.
- 2. Do a search for caches near you, and select one that looks like it would be an interesting one to look for. Take particular note of any details or clues. The cache can be well hidden.

3. Bring a small item for trading with the cache. This is a tradition of

geocaching. When you find the cache, you take an item from the container. Then you put something back in it for someone else to take.

- 4. When you get to the spot, hunt for the container. They are all sorts of sizes and shapes, but never hidden underground.
- 5. Exchange your item for an item in the container. The item of should be equal or lower value than what you are taking. Sign the log book and return the container exactly as you found it.



6. Log into the website or app and indicate you have completed this geocache.
