Choose a charity or good cause that you believe in. Frankly, the wider the appeal, the easier it will probably be to raise money. If there has been a lot of fundraising for a particular charity in your area, you may want to choose something different. People are usually reluctant to pay again and again to the same cause no matter how worthy. Choose a method of raising money; a few proven methods are shown below.

 Sponsorship for a physical challenge like running a marathon, 10,000 steps a day, or some other physical or mental

challenge. It does not matter what the challenge is, this is a proven way of getting people behind you.

- Host a yard sale, and donate the proceeds to a charity.
- Create a raffle. See if you can get some prizes, perhaps local businesses will donate items or services for prizes, and sell raffle tickets to raise money for the cause.
- Perhaps providing something as simple as babysitting, yardwork or other useful services around your community, that you and a group of friends could offer, with all proceeds going to the charity.



- Have a tournament-- it could be basketball, archery, or any of a number of challenges. People pay to enter and the winner gets a cash prize.
- Charity doughtnuts or chocolate bars. A number of companies offer charity packages that can be purchased and sold for a profit to be used as fundraising items.

And that's just a few ideas that can make a difference for the cause that is on your heart.
