But, what about a traditional clock with hands? Well, we need to make sure you are up to speed with those too, because they are all over the place.

Let's find a clock with hands and see how this crazy thing works.

EARN THIS NUGGET

Tell the time on an analog clock every day.
When you can tell the right time three times in a row, you'll have your Nugget.

- 1. Stand in front of the clock and see how the numbers go from one to twelve. As the numbers get higher, that's the direction those hands move around the clock.
- 2. Look for the little hand, now you know it travels from 1 to 2 to 3 and so on. So the chances are the little hand has gone past one number and is heading for another. What number has it just gone past? That is the hour ... it's something o'clock.
- 3. Now look for the big hand, it has probably just gone past a number also and is heading to the next one. What number has the big hand just gone past?
- 4. Well, every number on the clock is worth five minutes for the big hand. So if the big hand is on the 2 it is 10 minutes past something. If it is on the 6 then is 30 minutes past something and if it is on the 9, it is 45 minutes past.



5. Put those together then, your hour and how many minutes past the hour it is. It looks kinda crazy, but you'll have it in no time.
