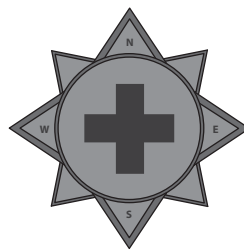


SECURING THE HOME

- For the next two weeks, at night and when you leave the house as a family, it will be your responsibility to check doors and windows.

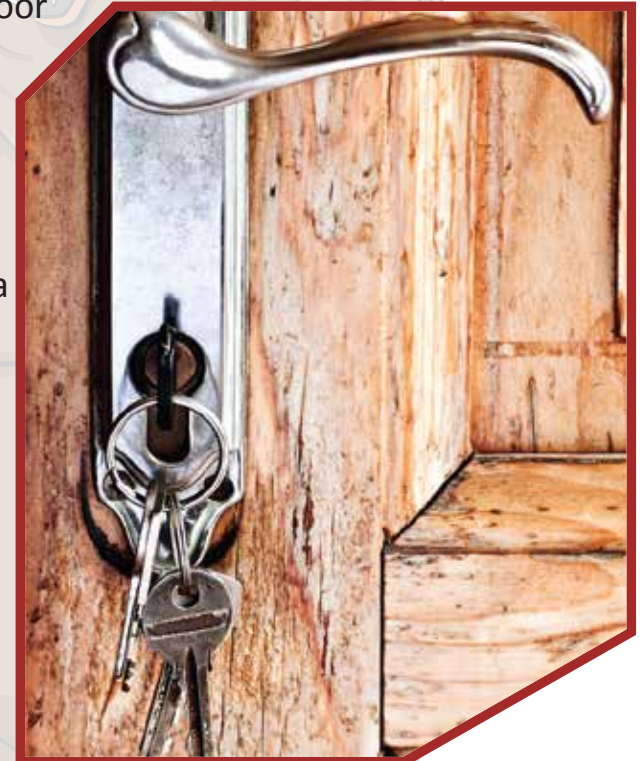
