- Successfuly tell the time ten times during the day when asked.
- Parents, give your Skill Trekker three times to watch for on three separate occasions, perhaps dinner time or bath time.

So, let's look at this really important skill.

- 1. Get yourself in front of a digital clock. It may be a watch, an alarm clock, or maybe the clock on the stove or microwave.
- 2. Now on the far left, you'll see two numbers, it may say 01 or 02, or just "1" or "2" by itself, all the way up to 12 because there are 12 hours in a day. So, that number means that it is something o'clock.

3. Next, there are two more numbers after the first usually with a ":" in between them. This will be a number between 01 and 60 because there are 60 minutes in an hour. This, then, represents the minutes past the hour.

So then, if you saw the number 5:32 that would be five thirty-two. Or we could say, thirty-two minutes past five o'clock.

And if we saw 09:15,

that would be fifteen minutes past nine, or nine fifteen, or even a quarter past nine,

Good deal, you'll be telling time like a pro in no time.
