Use a weed whacker in the garden on two separate occasions or in two separate gardens.

So, here's correct use of this most awesome weapon of garden domination:

1. Safety first. Eye protection is non-negotiable. Don't have any, then don't weed-eat. It will propel rocks and debris at high speed and you will be hit by some of it.

2. Shorts are cool in the summer. But it is probably a torture regime somewhere in the world to make prisoners weed-eat in shorts and flip flops. A good pair of jeans and old pair of running shoes will go a long way to protect your tender flesh. Also

have a pair of work gloves.

- 3. Now, setting up the whacker. Set the string long and keep it long. Most have an automatic, or semi-automatic way, of feeding the string. The end of the string is the part that is moving the fastest. Having a long string increases the amount of carnage you can deliver in a single rotation.
- 4. Make note of the head rotation and cutting angle so debris is projected away from you. Be

cautious around fences and walls. Debris can easily bounce back and pelt you.

5. Be careful of any objects in your path, especially people. Don't use a weed whacker with anyone near you.
