- 1. Get yourself a piece of flat ribbon with an appropriate width for the package you are wrapping
- 2. Wrap the ribbon around the box, laying it over the top face and then meeting the two ends at the bottom.
- 3. Now, here is a tricky part, tie the ribbon as though you were going through the first step of tying your shoes and then take the ribbon ends up the other sides of the box. The ones that don't have any ribbon on them yet.
- 4. When you get to the top, tie again with the same kind of knot. But this time you'll finish it off exactly like a completed shoelace bow.



- 5. Trim the ends to the right length and you are ready to impress the world.
